1st-2nd Grade

Bible

In our early elementary Bible class we will use Apologia's Word in motion to guide us through the Old Testament. We will explore key people, places and events of God's awesome story of love for humanity and his plan for our redemption.

Science

Using beautifully illustrated science books, students will discover the wonders of God's creation through age-appropriate lessons, hands-on experiments, demonstrations, and interactive activities. Throughout the year, they will explore a variety of science topics while developing observation skills, asking thoughtful questions, and cultivating a love for learning about the world God has made.

Art through World History

In this class, we will journey through time, from the Garden of Eden to today, discovering history through hands-on art projects inspired by the people, cultures, and time periods we explore.
